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Specialist Consultancy Suites EOI

Introduction

Hume City Council would like to invite interested not-for-profit or philanthropic community health and wellbeing service providers as well as allied health service providers to submit an Expressions of Interest (EOI) for the let or hire of consultancy suites within the community centres located in Broadmeadows, Craigieburn, Greenvale, Kalkallo and Mickleham.

The consultancy suites are co-located with Council's Maternal and Child Health services and generally share the same waiting area. There are five consultancy suites currently available for hire for the delivery of services that respond to local community needs.

Hume City

Hume City is one of Australia's fastest growing and culturally diverse communities and is home to more than 241,000 residents. Hume spans a total area of 504 square kilometres and is in Melbourne's northern fringe, just 15 kilometres from the centre of Melbourne.

The City has a rich history that stretches back over 40,000 years, when the indigenous communities of the Gunung-Willam-Balluk first inhabited the region and still has a significant proportion of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders living within its municipal boundaries. Hume residents come from 156 different countries and speak over 150 languages - with two out of every five residents speaking a language other than English.

Hume City is experiencing rapid residential growth, particularly in its northern areas. It is anticipated that the residential population in Hume City will increase from 241,018 in 2020 to 310,312 by 2030 and to 367,354 by 2040. This rapid population growth translates into growing community and wellbeing service needs within the municipality.

Consultancy suites in Hume Community Centres

Access to community services is fundamental to the liveability of a community and of residents' collective and individual overall health and wellbeing.

Everyone should be able to access services where they live to support residents leading happy, healthy and fulfilling lives. Rapid population growth has meant people living in developing residential areas often do not have access to timely and essential community health and wellbeing services and therefore need to spend time and money commuting to access services outside of their neighbourhoods. For some, they do not access services at all – leaving them at risk of poor health outcomes.

Hume City Council has recognised the urgency of locally accessible community services for residents and has ensured that the design of its community centres enable the accommodation of co-located Council services with other non-council services. Council's integrated Community Centre model provides opportunities for community health and wellbeing service providers to be co-located within the facility, thereby providing greater continuum of care and support for Hume residents.



The Proposal

Hume City Council has several consultancy suites available for licencing or hire to suitable services providers. The design of the facilities includes two or more consulting suites with the expressed idea that not-for- profit service providers could hire/licence spaces and thereby close the service delivery gaps that are apparent in existing or newly established residential communities.

Another purpose for the provision of the consulting suites is to secure services that could underpin the service delivery principle of a continuum of care and support – including services required for children and their families. The benefits of co-location with other services provides opportunities for collaboration, referral pathways and community-centered approaches to service delivery.

Service delivery goals

It is important not only to attract the right kind of services into the consultancy suites that respond to community need, but also the right strategic fit of the service provider within the Community Centres.

The following service delivery goals have been developed to guide the EOI application and evaluation process and include:

People: to provide welcoming and peoplecentred services, care and opportunities to communities that will improve their capacity to look after themselves, their families and others. **Partnerships:** to participate in collaborative approaches with other services to achieve the best outcomes for their clients, other users of the Centres and the wider community.

Practice: to promote practices that are high quality, safe, inclusive, accessible and provide the best strategic fit for the Community Centres.

Place: to progress a continuum of services and care under the one roof (or within the community through outreach) that responds to the local needs of the community (catchment-based servicing).

Fees and charges

Licence: Suitable applicants will be invited to enter into a ILicence for their preferred space in accordance with Council's Licence and Lease Policy.

- A Licences can be issued from two years or longer with a maximum term of five years.
- The Llicence rental will be calculated in accordance with Council's Lease and Licence Policy (a copy of this policy is available upon request)
- A Licence Agreement includes an early termination clause where either party can provide three months written notice for any reason to terminate the Licence.

Regular/Casual Hire: Consultancy suites can be hired for casual/regular hire. The following table provides indicative hire rates across the Community Centres for the Consulting Suites:

Introduction

Hume City Council has multiple co-located consultation suites available for hire by community health and wellbeing services providers. Aitken Hill Community Centre



Aitken Hill Community Centre is situated at **40 Waterview Boulevard, Craigieburn** near the Aitken Hill Primary School and within a five minute drive of Craigieburn Central.

The centre accommodates three Preschool classrooms, two Maternal Child Health nurses and monthly scheduled immunisation sessions. In addition, a wide range of community activities and programs, including children's dance classes, yoga, self-defense and supported playgroups are provided within the facility.

Broadmeadows Community Hub

The Broadmeadows Community Hub is a modern two-storey facility, situated at **180 – 182 Widford Street, Broadmeadows** and within walking distance to the Olsen Place shopping mall. Accessible by either lift or stairway, Consulting Suite 1, is located on the first floor of the building and conveniently positioned next to the Maternal and Child Health Consulting rooms.

The Hub is home to Dallas Neighbourhood House and Broadmeadows Residents Advisory Group. The Broadmeadows Community Hub hosts five Supported Playgroups, two Maternal Child Health nurses and a wide variety of community activities and programs.

Greenvale West Community Centre



Located at **7 Ventura Way, Greenvale**, the Greenvale West Community Centre is a newly constructed facility which opened in May 2021. There are two consulting suites presently available for immediate use. The consulting suites are situated opposite the Reception Office, adjacent to the centre's main entrance. The consulting suites share a waiting room with the Maternal and Child Health consulting suites and are acoustically treated to protect privacy.

Co-located and existing services at the Greenvale West Community Centre include three preschool classrooms, two Maternal Child Health nurses and fortnightly or bi-monthly scheduled evening immunisations.
