- Copper sheet 1mm thick (approximately 100x100mm)
- Sterling silver round wire 1mm wide (approximately 200mm long)
- Silver solder wire .5 thickness EASY and HARD
- Adjustable saw Saw blades I bundle
- size 2/0 Drill bits one of each size 1mm; 1.5mm; 2mm
- Emery paper 1 sheet of each grade 240, 400, 600, 800, 1000, 1200
- Titanium soldering pick
- Tweezers
- Fine basic brush
- Notebook,
- pen and pencil
- Black marker fine
- Scissors
- Small metal ruler
- Safety goggles
